Dear Summer Camp Families,

We are very excited to bring our summer camp program back this year! We have made a few changes to our program that we hope our campers and families will enjoy. Summer camp will only be available for elementary students between the ages of 6 and 10. Summer camp will start on Monday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> and go through Friday, August 1<sup>st</sup>. We will be closed on Friday, July 4<sup>th</sup>. The hours for our summer camp program will be 7:30am-4:30pm. There will not be before or after care available outside of these times. The summer camp classroom this year will be held in our remodeled lower level. The rate for summer camp will be \$150/week. Your child can attend the weeks that you choose! Please mark on the enrollment form which weeks your child will be attending. Due to staffing, we must limit each week to 16 children. Each camper will get an ELC Summer Camp T-shirt, these shirts are mandatory on off campus field trip days!

We have five planned bussed field trips that include campers going to: Theis Farms, a Hoot's Baseball Game, Big Joel's Safari, the bowling alley, and the movie theater. We are also bringing in several other activities for the campers to enjoy such as a pottery kit from the Painted Pot, Kona Ice truck, and a bounce house. In the enrollment packet you will find a complete description of all of our planned activities for this summer.

Campers will need to bring a sack lunch and a water bottle every day. They should also bring a morning and afternoon snack. Campers will be spending a lot of time outside, weather permitting, so please apply sunscreen to your child each morning. Campers may bring sunscreen to camp to reapply mid-day. Campers should also bring a book each day to read during our ½ hour quiet time. Please do not bring gaming devices or electronics such as tablets. We are not responsible for lost or broken items from home.

Water play day for summer campers will be every Thursday (weather depending). Please send a swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, and an extra bag to put wet suits and towels in!
